Improving the Use of Project Management Tools in Education for Systemwide Initiatives

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INTRODUCTION

Healthcare systems are challenged with competing demands for change with enhanced technological innovations, new regulations, improved safety protocols, and changes in disease management therapies. Existing processes to handle these rapid changes were not efficacious in the quest for excellence; therefore, a team of system education leads developed a formal, standardized process and structure to improve the oversight, planning and implementation of education for systemwide clinical initiatives.

GOALS

- Improve clinical outcomes
- Streamline and bundle educational opportunities to improve understanding
- Determine project weight based on resources needed, scope of impact and time
- ❖ Provide an awareness of the number of initiatives occurring at once that affect pace of work for frontline staff and managers
- Decrease competing priorities for learning while improving staff satisfaction

ACTIONS

Sentara Healthcare expanded from a 7 to a 12 hospital system from 2012 to 2015. Clinical initiatives, quality and safety processes, technological advances and the quest for excellence happens differently when managing change with system expansion. Application of project management tools were used in educational rollouts to improve clinical standardization.


 Created to capture all rollouts and colorcoded for: Equipment, IT, QI/Process Changes and Bundled Education (see example 2014 Master Gantt below)

OUTCOMES

- ✓ Utilization of project management principles and tools enhanced the Nurse Staff Development Educators' abilities for success as they became more involved in implementing changes in systemwide clinical initiatives.
- ✓ Tools and Templates created were effective in submitting organized, realistic, and achievable education plans to compliment the rapid pace of system rollouts.
- ✓ Educators successfully utilized the new methods to rollout on-time training plans across a 12 hospital system.
- ✓ Master Gantt Calendar and Project Intake made a positive impact with continued, increasing use.
- ✓ In 2015, the amount of rollouts decreased to front line staff at one time due to bundling and focus on pace of work.
- ✓ The percentage of bundled learning projects nearly quadrupled in 2 years.
- ✓ Greater than 97% end user training compliance in 2015.
- ✓ Consults for clinical project intakes tripled by utilizing the new processes and tools.
- ✓ New executive-level team launched in May 2015 to schedule and coordinate approved projects that impact clinical front line staff across the entire system.
